Our PTSA Dollars at Work: Joe Leibson (Spanish)

Mr. Leibson detailed how the purchase of 10 iPads with PTSA dollars has benefited the foreign language programs at BCS. Use of the iPads includes:

- Speaking Tests (students record themselves and submit to teacher)
- NearPod – Interactive slides are used to engage students, connect them in discussions, and informally assess student progress
- Kahoot! – Teachers use this game-based learning platform to assess vocabulary understanding.
